



Gaja 'Dagromis' Barolo, Piedmont (NB)

An amazing Barolo from one of the biggest names in Italian wine. Named for the Gromis family, who owned the prized vineyard in the commune of La Morra, where much of the fruit for this wine comes from. Intensely rich and full, this Barolo is a deep red, with ripe berry and floral aromas along with nebbiolo's characteristic spice, a touch of licorice and herbs. The wine is solid on the palate, with a rich softness. Aged for 12 months in barrique and another 12 in large oak casks, this is a particularly Gaja-styled Barolo that lovers of the Italian powerhouse should not pass up. **\$151.95**

Chateau Mont Redon Chateauneuf -du-Pape, Rhone (GR, SY, MV)

The historic appellation of Châteauneuf-du-Pape is one of France's most diverse regions with no less than 13 varieties permitted under the excisting regulations. As the largest single-vineyard estate in the region, Château Mont-Redon is one of the few producers who cultivates them all although in the red cuvee's. This intense wine shows prunes, dried black berries, leather and gamey characters on the nose. The palate opens soft, supple and smooth with sweeter Grenache fruit dominant while the mid-palate and finish show fresh acidity and minerality to provide a perfect balance to the weight and tannins of the Syrah and Mourvedre. **\$71.95**





Masi 'Costasera' Amarone Classico, Veneto (RO, MO, CR)

Amarone is a unique wine due to its origin, ancient grape varieties and production method (vinification of grapes that have been semi-dried for 3-4 months on bamboo racks). Deep opaque red with violet tinged edges. Rich, powerful bouquet with aromas of baked fruit, cooked with herbs and spices. The alcohol content plays its usual role in cutting the sweetness on the palate. Cherry fruit preserve and cinnamon are the major components in a long-lasting and attractive finish. Amarone is a full-bodied wine for grilled or roasted red meats, game, and strong tasty cheeses, such as parmesan. Generally considered a wine for meditation, it is a great after-dinner wine. **\$97.95**

Torres Salmos, Priorat, Spain (CR, GR, SY)

This Wine is a homage to the monks of the courageous carthusian order, who arrived in 'Priorat', in 1095, where they cultivated vines. In 1835 a violent crowd destroyed the work of a lifetime and sacked the monastery, events which later culminated in the auctioning of church lands known as the "Desamortización de Mendizábal". In 1996 the Torres Family began work on the planting of vineyards on the slopes strewn with the hard, black slate-like "Licorella" stone. Dark in hue and almost opaque, it is fragrant and mineral on the nose while on the plate it is luxurious and oily, but also silky and with a long finish. This darkly coloured wine is reminiscent of jam and liquorish, over a smooth spicy and toasted background. **\$63.95**







Celani Family Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa


Cabernet Sauvignon is a noble wine whose berry-black fragrance and flavor is a famous mixture of currants and cassis. It ages beautifully in our new French oak barrels, in that ancient interplay of time and tannin, to a deep, clear taste between medium and full-bodied that can only be described as classic Cabernet.


Ours is a carefully considered blend of 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot and 5% Merlot – for those first, second and third act sensations that linger on the tongue, and then in the mind and memory. **\$93.95**

Celani Family Vineyards Tenacious, Napa (MR, CF, PV)

The Celani Family Vineyard 2009 Tenacious is a blend of 69% Merlot, 28% Cabernet Franc, and 3% Malbec. Aged 20 months in 70% new French oak barrels, this blend was neither fined nor filtered. The immediate impression of this wine is aromas of black cherry, black raspberries, spicy blueberries, rhubarb pie, and creamy minerals. Subtle notes of tea-leaf box, sandelwood and marmalade compliment the aromatic landscape. In the mouth, the entry is powerful, seamless and rich: the fruit intensity is well-balanced with the evolved tannins.








Darioush Cabernet Sauvignon 'Signature', Napa

Inspired by the power and grace exhibited in the great wines of Bordeaux, Darioush Signature Cabernet Sauvignon exemplifies how the cooler-climate vineyards of southern Napa Valley produce wines with extraordinary depth, character and poise.

This wine offers great concentration of flavor, color and texture. Endowed with a sturdy core of earth, espresso and dark chocolate balanced by vibrant black fruits and savory layers of lavender and sage, this Signature Cabernet Sauvignon achieves both complexity and poise. We admire this wine for its dynamism and potential to outshine its siblings, while clearly maintaining the 'Signature' of this estate. **\$135.95**

Silver Oak Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa

Silver Oak Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon combines elegance and depth in a balanced expression of this classic California vintage. It has a dark ruby color with a garnet edge and a complex nose of sandalwood, cedar, cassis, black cherry, dark chocolate and roasted coffee. On the palate, it is extremely rich and mouth-coating and has a long finish of concentrated fruit and spice with a slight tannic grip. This wine is remarkable in how it continues to evolve in the glass over the course of a meal. It has great maturity of aromas and tannins at moderate alcohol. **\$149.95**








Livio Felluga Pinot Grigio, Friuli

This celebrated variety derives from a bud mutation of Pinot Noir. Pinot Grigio favours cooler climates and finds its ideal habitat on the hillsides. Livio Felluga's vinification technique gives the wine finesse and elegance while preserving the faint coppery highlights that are Pinot Grigio's hallmark. Without doubt, it is the best-known Friulian wine around the world. The aroma is extremely elegant, penetrating, crispy and complex, with evident notes of jasmine, and magnolia; hints of white peach, apricot, orange peel, pear, golden apple, cantaloupe, wild rose and mint; mineral and spice components well integrated. The taste is intense, vibrant, with good balance; great and persistent aromatics. **\$56.95**

Celani Family Vineyards Chardonnay, Napa

Chardonnay, the world's favorite dry white wine, is a balance somewhere between apple and oak, the brown barrel growing golden with wine. One of the most regal of all the white wines, it can still seem so much a part of the earth it comes from – an overgrown orchard's abandoned arbors, lost empty vineyards' wild ungathered grapes.

The Celani Family Vineyard's pure 100% Chardonnay is estate-grown and bottled. Finished in new French oak barrels, toasted individually to enhance the flavor and fragrance of the wine, it is unfiltered so the lees can settle to the bottom of the barrel and add immeasurably to its natural bouquet and taste. **\$61.95**
